

**THE PRESBYTERY OF LAKE HURON
SUMMARY OF THE STATED MEETING
October 2, 2007**

THE PRESBYTERY OF LAKE HURON held its October meeting at Kirkridge Presbyterian Church, Grand Blanc, Michigan.

THE VISIONING TEAM recommended and presbytery approved the elections of:

- The Rev. Richard Lawther as Synod Commissioner, Class of '08
- The Rev. Kenneth Hetzel as Synod Commissioner, Class of '07
- Elder Andrea Drapp three-year term as treasurer of the Presbytery of Lake Huron, effective January 1, 2007

THE STATED CLERK recommended and presbytery approved:

- the minutes of the August 7, 2007 presbytery meeting
- the request of the Rev. Chris Moody to serve communion at several events at Alma college through out the academic year
- the request of the Presbyterian Women to serve communion at the PW Fall Gathering
- the request of Fenton-Tyrone for an exception to and waiver regarding the election of an elder to more than two consecutive terms
- a report requested by the Synod on behalf of the Committee on Representation

The following items were reported for information:

- the following transfer requests are now complete:

- the dates for the 2007 and 2008 stated meetings and the need for invitations to the December 2, 2008 meeting
- the minutes of the Administrative Commission to install the Rev. Amanda Adams have been received
- official correspondences received from: the Rev. George Baird, Stated Clerk of the Synod; the Rev. Carol Gregg; Dr. Saundra Tracy of Alma College; the Rev. Chris Moody of Alma College; Nancy Taylor , Records Archivist at the Presbyterian Historical Society; Pamela Heavner, Clerk of Session at Fenton-Tyrone; Jeanette Hall, Clerk of Session at Flint-First

THE COMMITTEE ON MINISTRY reported for information that it approved:

- the 2008 Minimum Terms of Call
- Interim Pastoral relationship between the Rev. Dr. David Jackson and Flint-Community
- Granted the Rev. Chris Moody to labor within the bounds as Interim Chaplain for Alma College
- Pastoral relationship between the Rev. Dr. Randy Cullen and Holly
- Interim Pastoral relationship between the Rev. Marjorie Mair-Hansen (a UCC Minister) and Flint-First
- Presbytery approved a motion empowering the moderator, the Rev. Ken Hetzel, to appoint an administrative commission to install Dr. Cullen.

Summary of the October 2, 2007 Stated Meeting

THE ADMINISTRATIVE TEAM recommended and presbytery approved:

- to permit Twining-Maple Ridge to donate its former church building and relocate it to another site
- to enter into the application process as co-borrower with Flint-Trinity United for a loan

The team reported the following for information that they:

- approved the request of Alma College to solicit financial support for its Open Windows campaign
- reduced the listing price on the former Bay City-Covenant building

THE PRESBYTERY STAFF report emphasized the relationship between the governing bodies of the Presbyterian Church (USA).

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY COUNCIL report led members through an exercise that prioritized the goals on the Four Work Areas of GAC.

THE MODERATOR'S REPORT was presented to the presbytery in written form prior to the meeting.

A WORSHIP SERVICE was held with the Rev. Dr. David Pierce giving the sermon.

A STEWARDSHIP WORKSHOP was conducted by the Rev. Bill Carter.
